Berlin based Volker Meitz is a versatile keyboard player and producer, operating in genres ranging from Jazz to Pop to Electronica. He also is a sideman and producer for other artists.

Volker played with jazz acts like *Eric Schaefer, Kai Brückner, Chuck Loeb, Taiko Saito,* singers *Chima, Lisa Bassenge, Clara Hill, Astrid North,* Soul greats like *The Temptations* or *Ann Sexton* and Club acts like *Jazzanova* or *Analogue Freestyle* (one of the first German Drum'n'Bass live bands), performing around Europe and from New York to Beijing and Johannesburg.

As a session keyboarder, producer and remixer, Volker Meitz has worldwide releases to his credit; to name but a few, he has worked for *4 Hero (UK), Chari Chari (Japan), Dixon, Femi Kuti, P.Diddy, Popol Vuh, Jazz Indeed & Michael Schiefel,* producers *Patrick Majer* and *The Krauts*, as well as soundtrack remix for the Brazilian movie *"City Of God"*.

++ LONG VERSION ++

Born near Hamburg in 1974, Volker Meitz received classical piano lessons since age seven. As a teenager, he took on Jazz piano training, had his first appearences with a Synthie-Pop duo and played around North Germany with the Jazzfunk-Band *Bugging Operation*. His first steps as a composer and producer he made with what we call "Chiptunes" today: Under the nickname *PRI/Oxyron*, he released ca. 100 pieces of music in the 8-Bit computer scene of platform of that iconic little homecomputer called **Commodore C64**.

Having moved to Berlin in 1995, Volker got into the local Jazz and Electronic music scene, before long found himself playing with *Analogue Freestyle* (one of the first German Drum'n'Bass live bands) and met *Jazzanova*, who were looking for artists for their new label *Sonarkollektiv*; they released Volker's first professionally produced song ever on a compilation right away.

+ OWN PROJECTS +

Volker's solo project *Meitz* debuted with the *Africa EP* which became a club hit of the NuJazz scene, followed up by further releases and numerous remix requests for other artists – such as *Chari Chari* (Japan), *Phonique*, *Peace Orchestra*, 70ies-re-releases of "Kraut-Jazzers" *Missus Beastley* and Czech Jazz combo *Mahagon*, or for the soundtrack of the Brazilian movie *City Of God*.

In 2001 Volker took his 8-piece band on the road around Germany for the first time. Meitz' first longplayer "Vertikal" appeared on the Frankfurt based *Infracom* label in 2003, including collaborations with vocalists *Esther Cowens* (Jan Delay, Soulounge), *Vido Jelashe* (Noise Shaper, Tiger Hifi), *Twana Rhodes, Daniel Mattar* plus musicians of *Seed, Nylon, Tuomi, Lisa Bassenge* and *Berlin Bigband*.

In 2007, Volker Meitz launched **Sonar** *Kollektiv Orchester*, the *all star band* of the correspondent label. Next to arranging and producing the complete debut album in his humble studio, he also is their musical director on stage. In 2009, he recorded the Orchester for British NuJazz / Drum'N'Bass pioneers **4 Hero**.

Since 2011, Volker has been playing reguler gigs in Berlin with **Projekt Rhinow** – a trio together with Anders Grop (bass) and Rainer Winch (drums). For each concert, they recruit different guest musicians from Classical to Free Jazz, with the program varying accordingly, but always somewhere in the realm of Jazz. They have so far been joined by the likes of **Lisa Bassenge, Kai Brückner, Taiko Saito, Kalle Kalima, Silke Eberhard** and **Benny Lackner.**

+ SIDEMAN / PRODUCER +

Not least because of his sonic feel and creativity, Volker Meitz has been hired by artists from Jazz to Pop to Electronica. He played with singers like Clara Hill, Chima, Astrid North, Pat Appleton (Dephazz), Della Miles, jazzers like Ensemble Du Verre, Christoph Titz or Groove Galaxi and club acts such as Jazzanova or Didges Brew. Performing with backing bands Baltic Soul Orchestra and Heavy Mellow Quartet, he has been backing up legendary soul acts including The Temptations, Alexander O'Neal, Gloria Scott and Ann Sexton as well as US Jazzers Rick Braun, Richard Elliot and Chuck Loeb.

In the studio, he worked with the likes of Georg Levin, Jazz Indeed & Michael Schiefel, Eric Schaefer, House-DJ Dixon, Alex Barck, Moabit (Hip Hop), Dirk Berger & Vincent von Schlippenbach of producers The Krauts fame; his playing can be heard on remixes for P.Diddy, Femi Kuti, Popol Vuh, Fauna Flash.

Alessandro Allessandroni and others.

Volker wrote the score for the **musical play** "Verona Place", collaborating with New York based Author Nathan Youngerberg; he was part of the first performance in New York City.

+ TECHNICAL +

Besides music itself, Volker has always been fascinated by the technical aspect of sound synthesis and music production, which resulted in some respective studies, and eventually in a master's degree of Electro-Acoustical Engineering and Audio Communication from *Berlin Technical University*. He passes on his knowledge as a freelance teacher for audio engineering and sound design.

Last but not least, Volker has an own little production facility named **Nordkreuz Studio** where he produces his own stuff as well as records and mixes music for other artists.
